State of Wisconsin v. Kelly M. Rindfleisch (L.C. #2012CF438)

Before Curley, P.J., Fine and Kessler, JJ.

Kelly M. Rindfleisch petitions for leave to appeal a non-final order dated July 31, 2012, denying her motion to dismiss the criminal complaint issued against her. The State of Wisconsin filed a response opposing the petition. Upon review of the petition, response, and the circuit court order, this court concludes that the petition fails to satisfy the criteria for permissive appeal.

See Wis. Stat. § 808.03(2) (2009-10); State v. Webb, 160 Wis. 2d 622, 632, 467 N.W.2d 108 (1991).

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for leave to appeal is denied.
