## Dear Attorney Oswald:

No records can be provided in response to your Open Records request of January 2, 2014. The reasons for this are given below. Please refer to your request to identify the specific points addressed. The designations, a. through p., correspond to those of your request letter.

No records of internal or external communications concerning the phenomena described in your letter exist. This includes memos to WSLH staff, other agencies, instrument manufacturers, or individual persons; see your points a. through f.

No corrective actions were taken regarding the phenomena and no service calls were made; see points g and h.

There is no schematic diagram of the carrier gas installation for the instruments, nor is there any description of the carrier gas plumbing, routing, pressure regulation system, etc.; see points i. through k.

There are no records concerning electrical interference, radio frequency interference or similar phenomena; see point l.

Regarding materials requested in points m. through p., there is no list of chromatograms where the "jagged peak" phenomenon has occurred. Creating such a list is contrary to WS 19.31(1)(L). Your request to locate every instance of this phenomenon is overly broad, not tied to any particular specimen and without a reasonable limitation as to length



of time. Calls seeking to refine your request were placed to your office on 01/07/2014 and 01/13/2014, and have not been returned; consequently, no records can be provided.
