COMPLAINT

NOW COMES the Wisconsin Supreme Court - Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) by Litigation Counsel William J. Weigel, and alleges as follows:

- 1. The OLR was established by the Wisconsin Supreme Court and operates pursuant to Supreme Court Rules. This complaint is filed pursuant to SCR 22.11, based upon facts and misconduct previously the subject of a SCR 22.20 summary suspension proceeding.
- 2. David G. Dudas (Dudas) was admitted to the State Bar of Wisconsin in October of 1989 (State Bar ID No. 1018987). The most recent address furnished by Dudas to the State Bar of Wisconsin is McCanna, Dudas & Kewley SC, 4817 Barbara's Lane, Stevens Point, WI 54481-2504.

However, Dudas is currently in custody at the Outagamie County Justice Center, 320 South Walnut Street, Appleton, WI 54911.

- 3. On August 16, 2013, Dudas was charged with 31 criminal counts. State of Wisconsin v. David G. Dudas, Outagamie County Circuit Court Case No. 2013CF746 (the criminal case).
- 4. On April 30, 2014, following a trial in the criminal case, an Outagamie County jury found Dudas guilty of 30 criminal counts, including felony 1st degree sexual assault, felony 2nd degree reckless injury, felony substantial battery, fourteen counts of felony 2nd degree sexual assault, eleven counts of felony strangulation and suffocation, as well as a count of misdemeanor battery and a count of misdemeanor intimidation of a victim.
- 5. Dudas' criminal conduct reflects adversely upon his honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer in other respects.
- 6. Following the jury verdict in the criminal case,
 OLR moved for a summary suspension of Dudas' Wisconsin law
 license. On May 21, 2014, the Supreme Court of Wisconsin
 temporarily (summarily) suspended Dudas' law license,

pursuant to SCR 22.20. Office of Lawyer Regulation v. David G. Dudas, Sup. Ct. Case No. 2014XX568-D.

COUNT ONE

7. David D. Dudas committed criminal acts that reflect adversely on his honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer in other respects, in violation of SCR 20:8.4(b).

WHEREFORE, the Office of Lawyer Regulation asks that Attorney Dudas be found in violation of a supreme court rule as alleged in this Complaint; that the Court revoke Dudas' license to practice law in Wisconsin, and that the Court order such further relief as may be just and equitable, including an award of costs.
